We as the maintenance team and generous volunteers have put a lot of effort towards erecting the new cabin. We started the framing process shortly after the ballfield and range electrical power expansions were finished. I have learned a lot about framing new construction and building walls. After that, a group of four volunteers and I had an amazing time putting in the electrical for the cabin during one weekend. As of this letter, we are siding the building and hoping to wrap up the exterior for winter.

Additionally, we completed the electrical upgrades for the ballfield and shooting ranges! The ballfield now has new light posts for walkways and flood lights for outdoor activities. There are outlets in ideal locations

We completed almost all the soffit and fascia work around the exterior. We re-leveled a part of the first floor and are beginning work on the living room and laundry room.
