- **Day 3** We travel to Plimoth Patuxet Museums where we will have a Pilgrim/Wampanoag lunch, tour 17th century Plimoth and the Mayflower II, and learn about the faith of the Pilgrims. Afterwards, we head to our stay at Hyatt Boston-Braintree.
- **Day 4** We spend the day in Boston visiting the Boston Tea Party Ships & Museum, seeing 13 historic sites on a guided Freedom Trail walk, and touring the USS Constitution. We end our day with a delicious Italian meal followed by a show in Boston's Theater District.
- **Day 5** We start our Sunday by attending the historic Park Street Church before making our way to Gloucester, MA. We will have a tasty seafood lunch before embarking on a whale watching cruise narrated by a whale naturalist. Once back in port we travel to Portland, ME, and our Hilton hotel.
- **Day 6** We experience the city of Portland via a trolley tour, visit the Portland Head Lighthouse, tour the historic Victorian Mansion, and shop in the Old Port District. We end the day with a fine dining experience.
- **Day 7** We depart for a day trip to Boothbay where we will visit the Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens, enjoy a lobster lunch, embark on a Boothbay Lighthouses & Island Cruise, and browse the quaint shops along the wharf while enjoying the sights and sounds of a coastal fishing village.
- **Day 8** We depart for New Hampshire and drive along the famed Kancamagus Byway, one of the nation's most scenic fall drives. We will be making stops along the way for pictures and short walks in God's creation. After a lunch in Lincoln, NH, we travel through Vermont and stop at the Vermont Country Store before getting to the Hampton Inn in Albany.

COST:

The price of this ten-day package is **\$2,250** per person for double occupancy (triple occupancy is \$1,962). If you are single and would like to arrange for a roommate, please contact LLBC. If you would like to join us but would prefer a single room, the increased single-occupancy rate is \$3,060.

The price includes admission to all featured attractions, transportation in a deluxe restroomequipped motor coach, nine nights' lodging with hot breakfasts and baggage handling (**one** suitcase per person, please), our traditional first day box lunch, and one main meal per day. Daily devotionals, snacks, the services of your tour hosts and nurse, and lots of fun and fellowship are the icing on the cake for our bus tours!

A **deposit of \$225** per person must accompany your registration form with the balance due by August 15, 2025. After that date only half of your fee will be refunded should you need to cancel. The overnight fee for staying at Lake Lundgren the night before the trip, should you need to, is \$30.00 per person in a cabin with a bathroom. An overnight stay includes a cup of coffee and pastry to get you started for the day on Wednesday morning.
