We hope your summer is going well. Things in the Ambrosius family have been busy and we are excited to get you caught up.

Ministry Update:

Role Change:

We have been experiencing record camper demand, and we desire to grow to meet this need. For example, this year we opened summer camp registration on January 10th and within 24 hours we had over 1,200 registrations. Within two weeks of registration being open summer camp was basically full. Because of this demand, LLBC hired an architect firm to help develop a master plan for us as we look to grow our facilities to welcome more campers. With these new endeavors on the horizon, **I have transitioned roles from Program Director to Advancement Director.** In short, my new position will be responsible for coaching staff on support raising, ministering to LLBC's donors, and working towards growing our donor base as we look to continue to improve facilities and grow LLBC for the future. Please know we are taking great care in making sure the feel and culture of LLBC will stay the same as we develop and implement our master plan for the future. I want to express my deep gratitude for your faithful generosity over the years in supporting the Ambrosius Ministry at Lake Lundgren Bible Camp. Your partnership has made it possible for us to serve full-time in ministry, and we don't take that for granted. With my recent transition into a new role at LLBC, our financial needs have shifted. For the past nine years, we have been responsible for raising our full salary through support. Now, due to the nature of my new position—focused primarily on donor care and fundraising—LLBC has intentionally structured things so that I am responsible for raising just \$20,000 annually for personal support. This adjustment helps avoid any potential conflicts of interest as I interact with donors on behalf of the camp. Nikki and I have individually connected with each donor that we would like to stay on our donor team. If you have not been asked, we would love for you to consider continuing your generous support—just in a new way. One opportunity is to give to the LLBC Legacy Fund, which is helping launch future growth initiatives to reach more campers with the Gospel.
